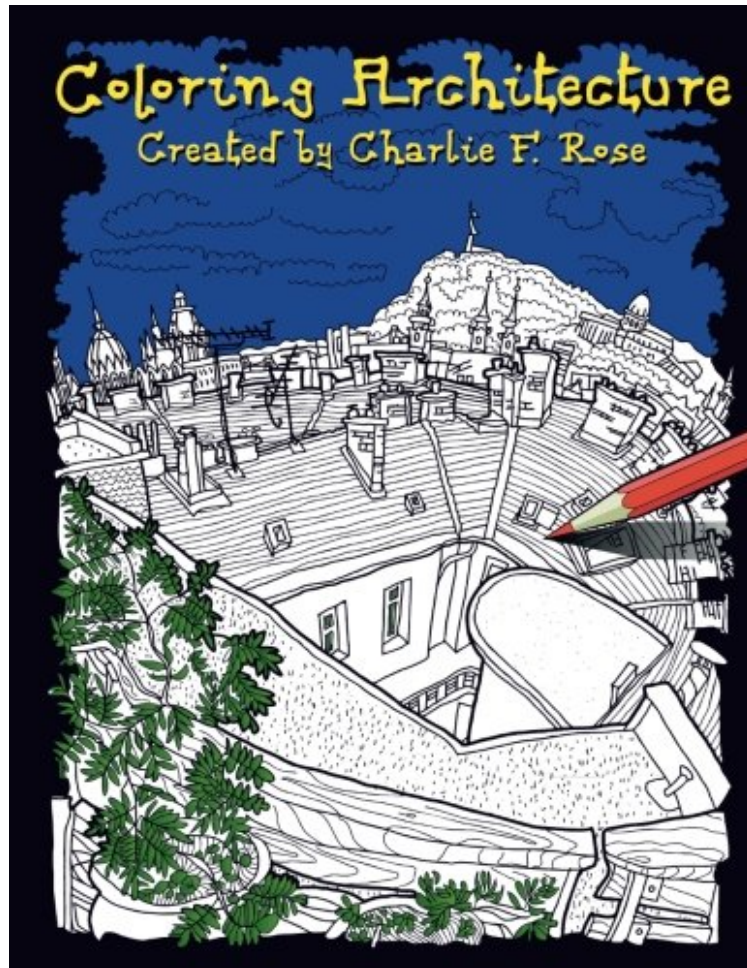

I love that initially these drawings were not produced for a coloring book, rather these are random drawings of the artist (who is an architect). As I understand, he literally created them while walking in these cities."Coloring Architecture" by Charlie F. Rose has a fantastic collection of a huge variety of cities from Central and Eastern Europe. I bought this book for my friend, who is also an architect, for his birthday. He loved it! The drawings include places and buildings in Italy, Switzerland, Austria, Hungary, and the

Czech Republic. Real cities plus the imagination of the artist... In this art album-turned-coloring book, his fascinating space bending perspective is shared with us for the first time. The book is 8.5 by 11 inches and has 56+1 intricate designs. The +1 is a beautiful preview from the next book, already in the making! For convenience, each design has an empty back. The pages are bright white, perfect for coloring. If you use inks, I suggest using a sheet of freezer paper behind the page you are working on to keep the inks from bleeding through to another page. It is nice that each design is labeled with identifying information in the artist's own handwriting. The copyright information is on the back of each page so that when you wish to mount and frame the pages, the image can be fully appreciated as an art work. This should be a lovely book for taking stress away. Each project will take some time to finish, depending on your eye for detail. Note: For fine, organic details use fine tools. This book is a feast for those who appreciate the art form of coloring a wonderful birthday present and/or a Xmas gift.

I am just beginning to figure out how I am going to use it. As the drawings are from several cities across Europe I think I am going to try to find color photos of SOME of the locations and aim for similarity in color. On others I may just shoot the moon! The book is different. The covers feel sort of like moleskin. The pages for coloring are one-sided allowing I guess for removal from the book and displaying as one might see fit. The drawings range from somewhat simple to very detailed. Some feel like I can wing it others almost like I need to plan ahead. I purchased one for my girlfriend who already colors and one for me. Now we are long distance lovers so I will not be seeing her for almost two months. We both are looking forward to comparing our work when we are next together!

I created the drawings in this art album/coloring book By A Friend of San Francisco On my drawings I attempt to stretch 3 or more dimensional spaces and buildings onto a 2 dimensional surface (paper). Some of these images show the sights from 2-3 points of view, this is why some of the hidden details become visible that when observed from only one angle are invisible. It appears as if perspective does not exist, and yet I aim to create a perfectly understandable spacial experience. The spacial structures can be untangled, and since the sights were crumpled by a human brain, another human brain is able to spread them out again. Apparently surreal, yet real cityscapes are born that are recognizable when you know or visit the places. I hope that while coloring the images you will be able to understand even the small details. I wish you a fun time with my art! Here are a few words from the editor, Regina Saphier: "I am the editor and indie first time publisher of this book. Charlie F. Rose is a talented graphic artist and I wanted to help him market his art globally. It has been a thrilling journey from the moment I told him that I think his drawings would make a beautiful coloring book for grownups seeking flow and relaxation, to the moment the first order was placed on . I am a visual artist myself and initially I conceptualized some of my own drawings as a coloring book for grownups, but I was just starting to accumulate enough drawings while Charlie already had hundreds after 15 years of walking and drawing. I knew that his art could add a uniquely organic and space bending spin to coloring. These images are for people with artistic taste. Imagine sitting with the artist on the street and learning to twist space in your mind. His pencil lines are characteristically dynamic. Because I am lucky to know him well, I also know that he will be delighted by your coloring choices. All that matters is that you enjoy the process alone or in a group. One more thing! Since I work on my original art, I am going to look at this book as an art album and I know that many of you will do the same. Rose is an architect and graphic artist who is often standing in the hot summer sun or ignores an autumn drizzle resisting the elements, steadfastly drawing what his consciousness registers while looking at other fellow architects' building dreams that materialized from architectural drawings in the first place...
