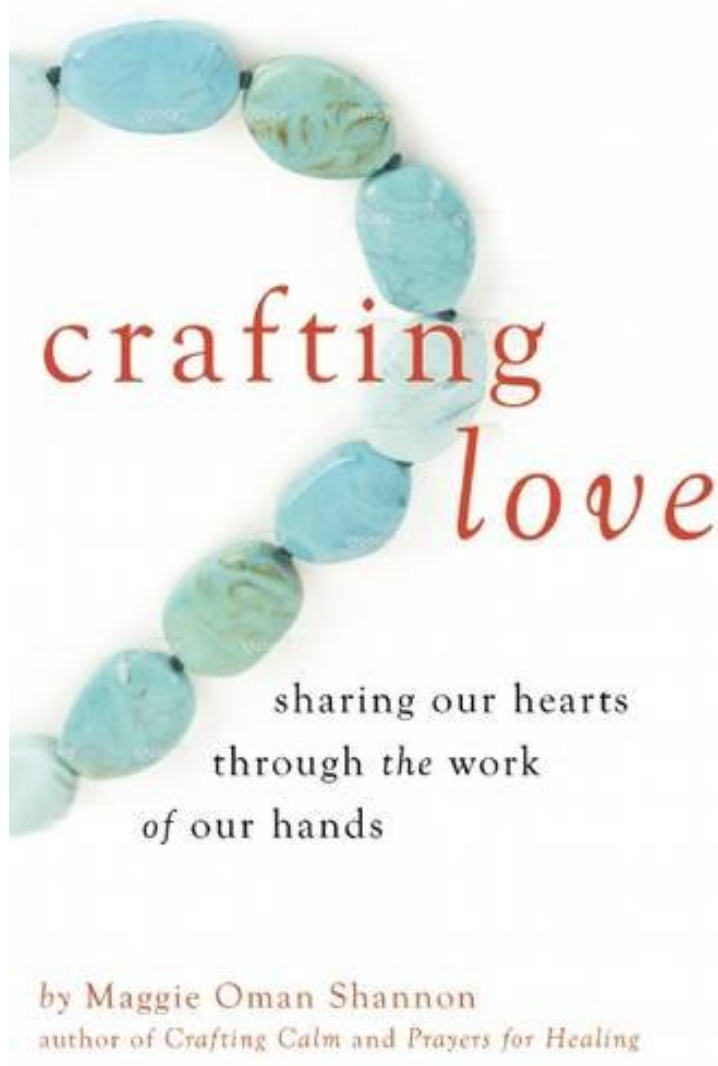

In 2000, Rev. Maggie founded *The New Story*, a coaching and consulting business focused on helping people create deeper meaning in their lives. Her writing has appeared in publications including *Utne Reader* and *Beliefnet.com*, and her work has been featured in publications ranging from the *San Francisco Chronicle* to *Spirituality Health*.
