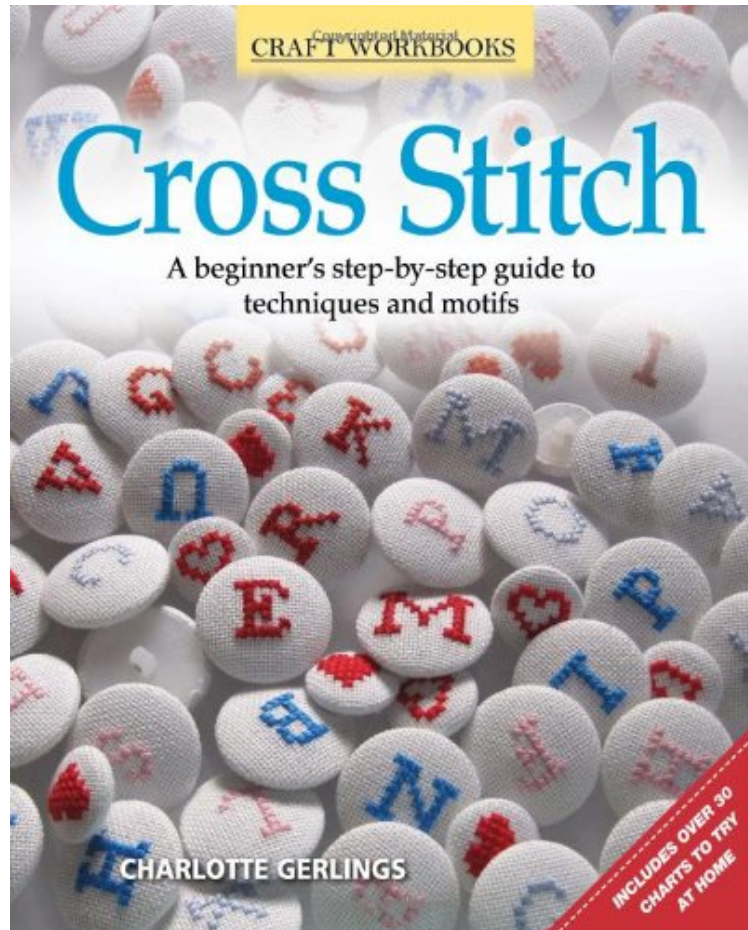


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Cross Stitch: A beginner's step-by-step guide to techniques and motifs (Craft Workbooks)
