She has her own long-running cross stitch magazine in England and has written over two dozen books. The book is for kids to learn how to cross stitch with easy designs they might like. It states on the cover there are but 10 projects. The majority of projects are shown on the front and back covers. And you can buy this book for a song. What more could you expect?

Cross stitch is a simple and popular form of embroidery, and therefore suitable for children. Schools are using it as a craft and as a teaching medium - for maths projects, for example - and this is one of a series of books of projects for children under ten. The designs feature such themes as dinosaurs, spiders, skulls and bats. The step-by-step instructions and illustrations are accompanied by notes for parents and teachers, and advice on simple mounting and framing.

Both volumes contain identical directions for materials needed and how to stitch. Each project (11 in Dinosaurs and 10 in Farmyard) includes a clearly drawn chart, a full-color photograph of the finished product, and carefully written instructions.
