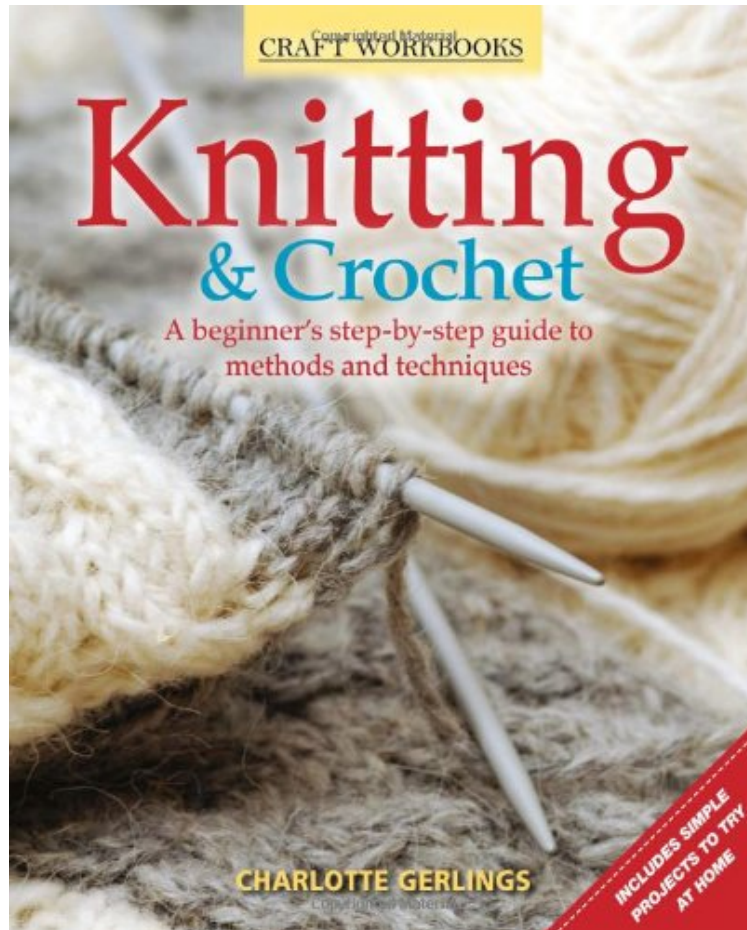

This is a plain and simple, cut to the chase way to learn to knit and crochet. The book also covers equipment, learning to read patterns and a glossary plus four simple patterns. You get a treat of a bit of history thrown in too. The illustrations are clear line drawings. For knitting you will learn to cast on, bind off, basic stitches, increasing, decreasing, knitting in the round and finishing. There are more tips and hints thrown in for good measure. Crochet instruction consists of chain, basic stitches, increasing, decreasing, geometric shapes, fastening, edging, finishing and some aftercare techniques.
