That makes it a bit hard to use as an e-book.I'm assuming Cross Mad got permission from Disney or would not have allowed the publication. Disney is very strict with it's copyrights.Big problem -- it's only volume one! It says "over 50" but yet this book, although over 400 pages long, is only 20 patterns. the other two volumes are also not free.Also -- these images are conversions from images to cross-stitch with little, if any, tweaking. Not the best quality in the world. It also begs the legality of this author's selections. If they are conversions, do they violate copyright?4 of 4 people found the following review helpful. There are no photos of the finished product, just a gray scale (not color) image of the animated character, but not of the finished cross

stitch, so you don't know how close to the animated character the finished piece will appear. There are no stitch counts, so you don't know how big or small the finished piece will be. It is a thick book, roughly one inch thick, so this would be difficult to work with while stitching, and would force the user to make copies of the needed pages. There is no table of contents so you can see what is in the book. It seems like someone bought a program that converts photos into patterns and whoever did the book compiled those patterns into a series of books. There's no thought, reason, or artistry here. The Disney character images are black and white images in the front of the book that have been pixelated to create a "cross stitch pattern". Each "pattern" is divided into sections over about 20 pages and would be extremely difficult to make, and no information is given as to how large the design is or what size fabric you would need. Not to mention, all the Disney images are copyrighted and is probably illegal to print!!!!
