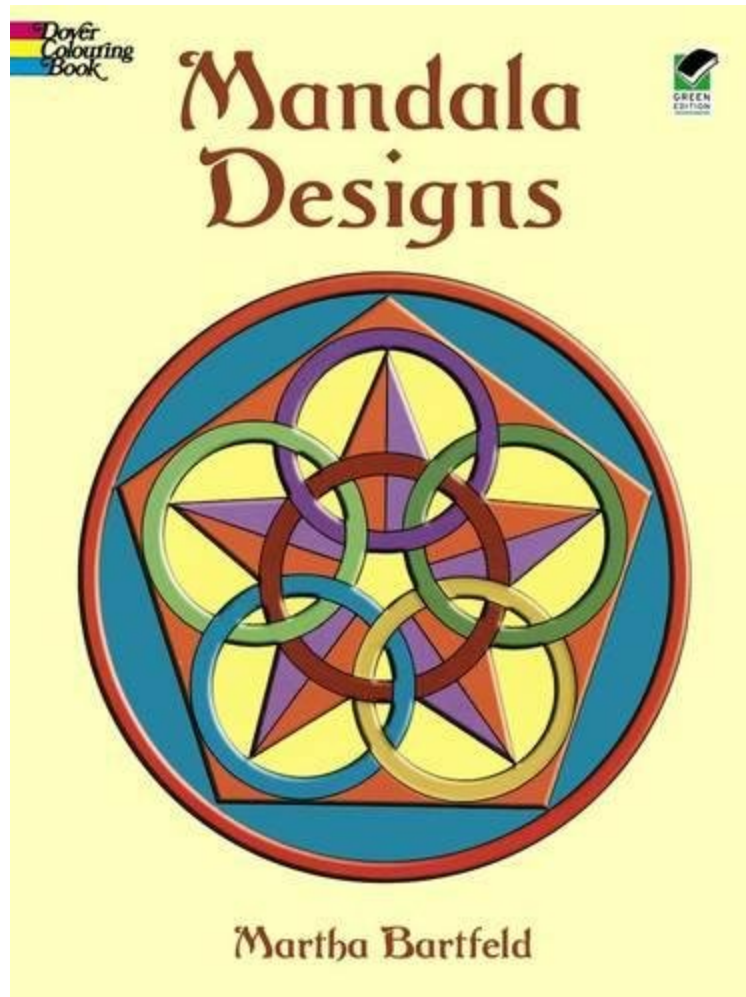

I will say they present you with a nice level of complexity and look very nice when colored. I use Prismacolor pencils and the tooth of the paper grabs the color nicely. Also like that the designs are not back and front on the page. I have a book like that, but color bleeds through if using markers and the pressure of using pencils leave the paper "weak". rendering the design on the opposite side useless. 3 of 3 people found the following review helpful.
