been doing origami for somewhere near 20 or 25 years now, and I rarely come across a book that challenges me anymore. I've made it through several books from John Montroll, Robert Lang, Hiromi Hayashi, and many others. This book definitely adds a whole new side to origami that I'm new to, and so far has been fairly challenging. The pros for this book, as I see them are:-very challenging models-very detailed models-small, concise no frills What I don't personally like:-there are very few actual directions in this book. The diagrams are decent, but there aren't very many actual directions. Several of the diagrams and steps are quite confusing.-The coloring/shading of the diagrams is very dark. Being mildly color blind, it makes it much more difficult to make out some of the proper folds.-each model I have worked on has required very fine paper. I have rice paper, but prefer to practice with cheap copy paper. You can't really do that with this book, the paper is just too heavy for these intricate folds. So, if you mess up or tear the sheet, it costs a whole lot more...SO, considering the above, I really do like this book. I intend to write scores of notes in it, and I've already started a binder to go with it that has step by step photos and examples of any steps that give me grief. This is definitely not a book for any sort of novice paper folder. If you cannot complete most every model

However, all the content is pictures of the origami creatures in stages without any description, and the printing isn't particularly high quality (at least, not in the copy I received), so I don't think any beginner or even intermediate to origami will find this useful. I have made origami creatures for years and I probably won't attempt most of these. There are better books out there.

The "dark side" of paperfolding awaits origami enthusiasts in this collection of new and interesting projects. Scores of diagrams and folding instructions show how to fashion creatures drawn from the worlds of fantasy and make-believe from a troll (23 steps) to a high-flying witch on a broomstick (141 steps). A useful list of symbols indicating basic folding techniques introduces 24 devilishly delightful models among them a bat, ghost, suit of armor, centaur, wizard, unicorn, satyr, sphinx, and a three-headed dragon. Offering hours of personal satisfaction and enjoyment, this unique collection will delight paperfolders at all skill levels from intermediate to advanced.
