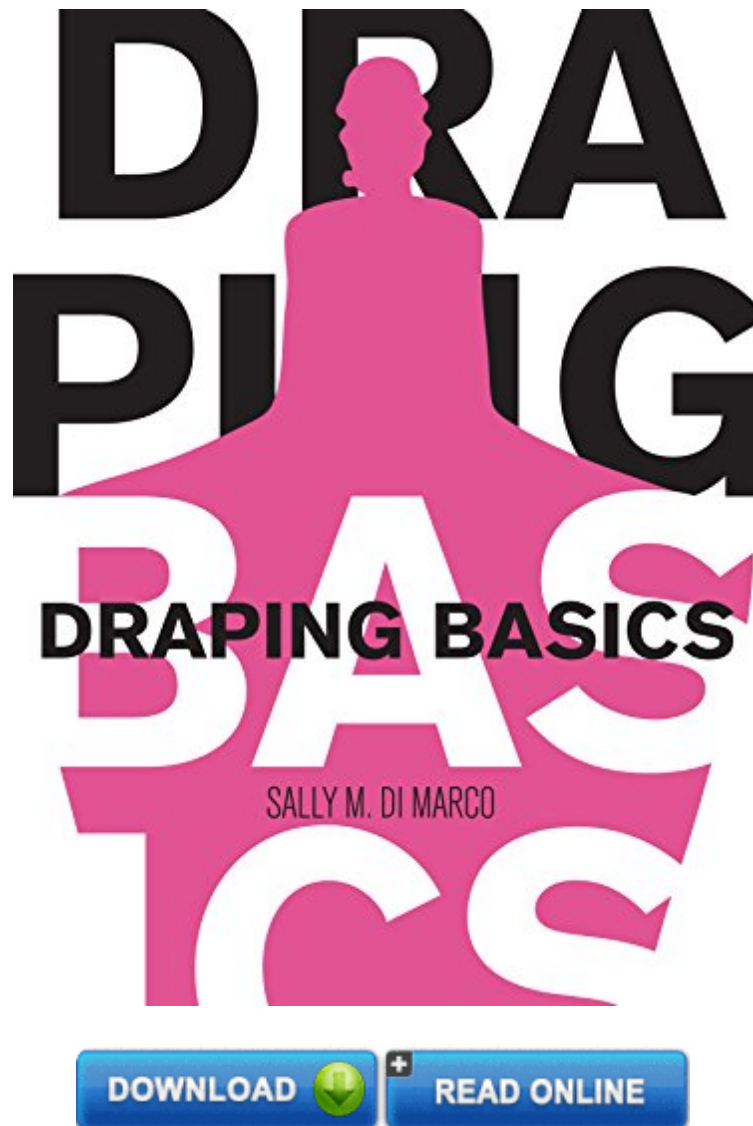

I have tried draping projects using both muslin and gingham - trust me when I say that you need the gingham! It is MUCH easier to see where the grainline falls when using gingham than when using muslin as gingham has vertical and horizontal lines you can follow while muslin is one solid color and no lines. I found it extremely easy to follow along and drape many different projects using this textbook. What I love about the book is that it is extremely easy to read/understand and easy to pick up the techniques - kind of like draping for dummies. I also like that this book

provides industry techniques, not just home sewing techniques like many other books. I want to know how the pros do it so home sewing techniques just won't cut it!
