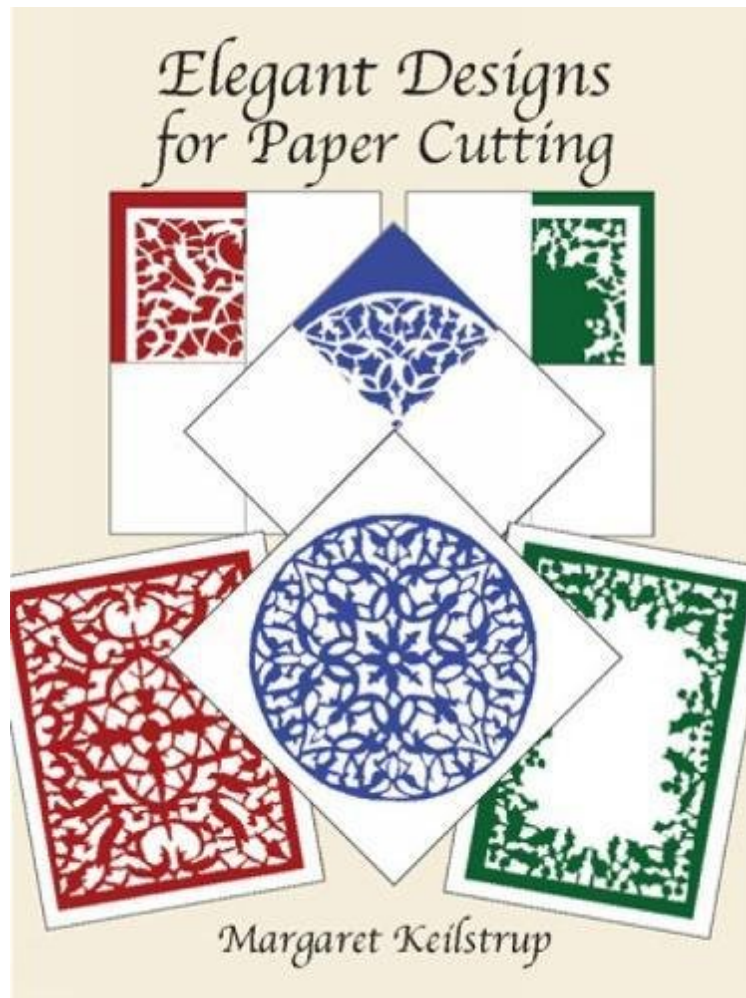

I use these designs primarily for making my own greeting cards, lining envelopes. Also, with the round patterns I make 2 or 3 copies of a pattern to make 3D Christmas ornaments (fold in center then stitch down the center, fold out to make a 4 or 6 sided

The pattern ideas are weak at best from what you can see of them. They are not crisp designs that you can scan or trace but blurry-edged designs that look more like torn paper art.
