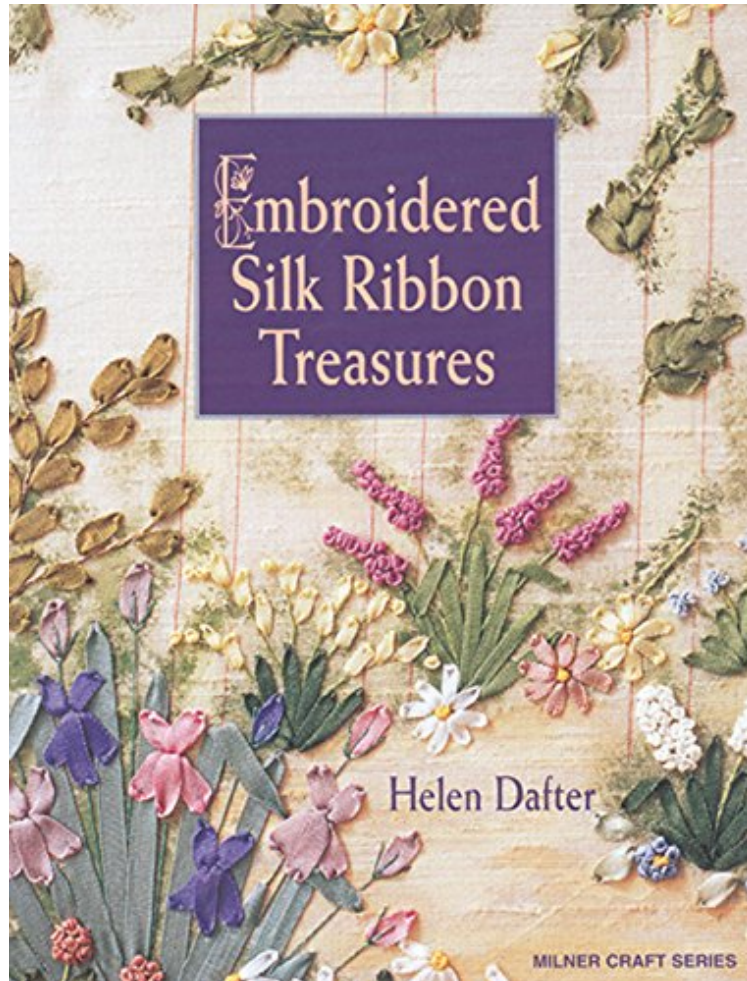

Nine pages of the book cover different stitches. These are mostly described by word. Each of these nine pages has a

vague drawing or two. There is one drawing for each stitch. Ten different stitches are covered, mostly regular embroidery stitches such as French knot, stem stitch and feather stitch . If you are looking for a book to teach you Silk Ribbon Embroidery stitches look elsewhere
