What a difference they are making in my ability to be creative with my Brother PE-500 embroidery machine. Books in the series all feature great directions, illustrations and best of all, most include a CD of very useful patterns. The patterns are my favorite part of the series. They are on the contemporary side and are set up so that you can mix and match elements of each design in many ways. For instance, a

design might be of a graceful fern overlaying a diamond shape- elements of the design that could be used separately might include: the outline of the diamond, the diamond in satin stitch, the outline of the fern's main stem, the satin stitched stem, the outline of the fronds, the satin stitched fronds. Photos and drawings illustrate ways to use separated elements in various combinations with elements of other designs- so many building blocks! This just opens a huge opportunity for creativity! I had resisted machine embroidery because the designs looked too "store bought" but these books show me how to develop projects that are uniquely mine. 1 of 1 people found the following review helpful.
