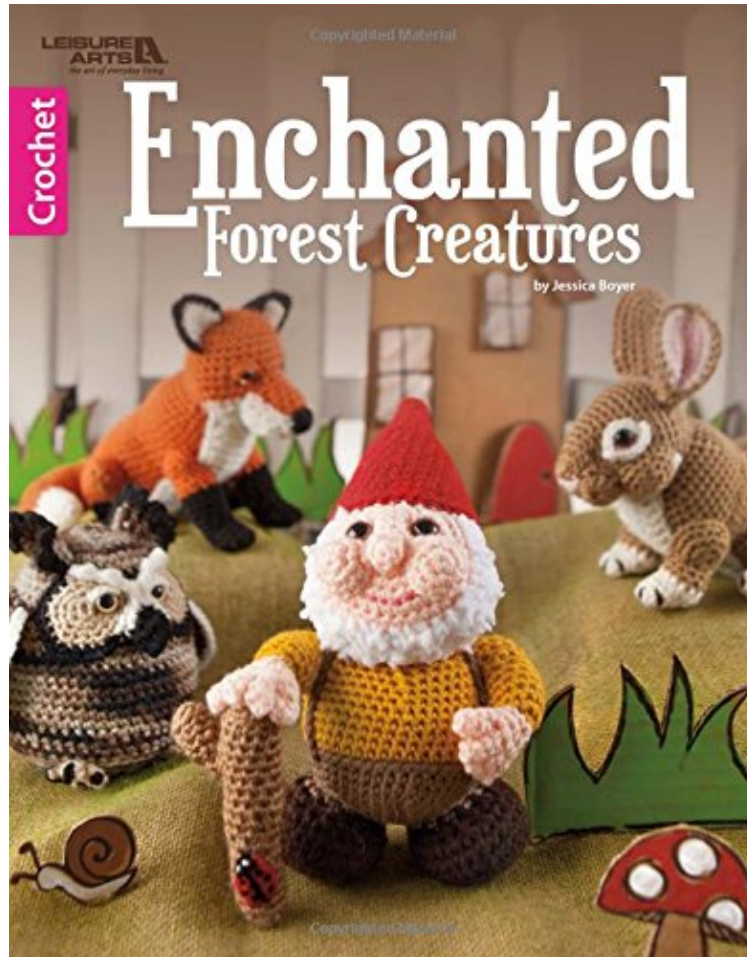

Step-by-step instructions are accompanied by close-up photos of the designs from various angles to show details of the faces and bodies.
