This is encased in a custom Plexiglas sleeve(the back and the front are both open so it's more of a sleeve then a slipcase). All of this is perfectly packed into shipping boxes so that it arrives in perfect condition.The content: FIT has chosen 100 designers and of them included multiple items.
