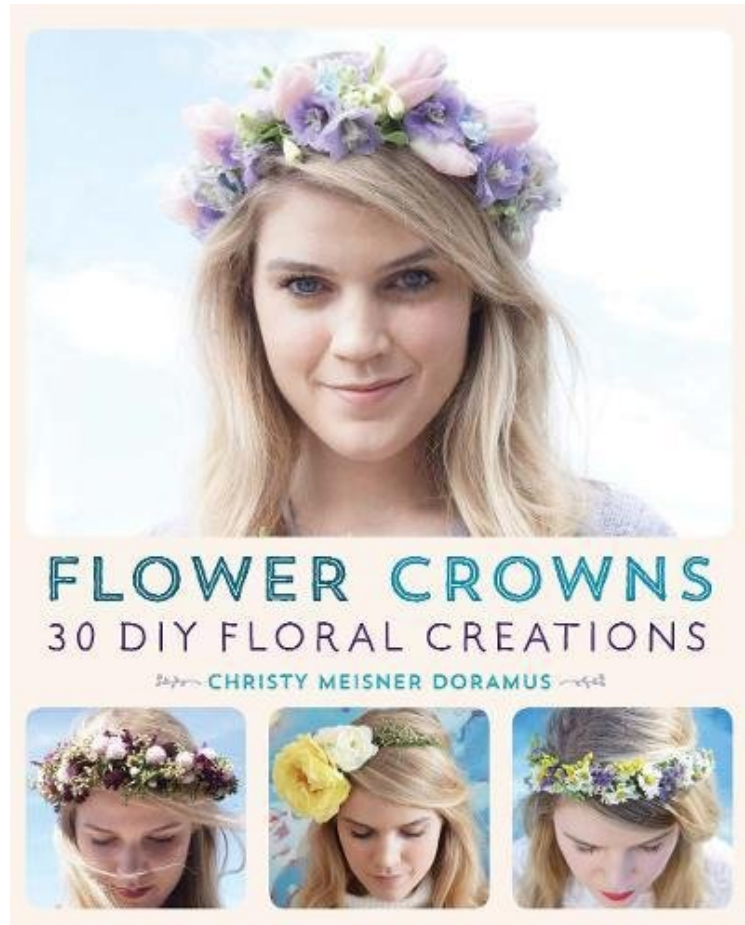

Doramus sections off her ideas for different crowns by season. She then gives the reader ideas for events that may coincide with said season. There's even a crown for Mardi Gras! There are so many different types of flowers to choose from (keep in mind when making a crown, some flowers may be seasonal) so a crown can be simple or quite elaborate based on the time commitment and skill set of the DIYer.
