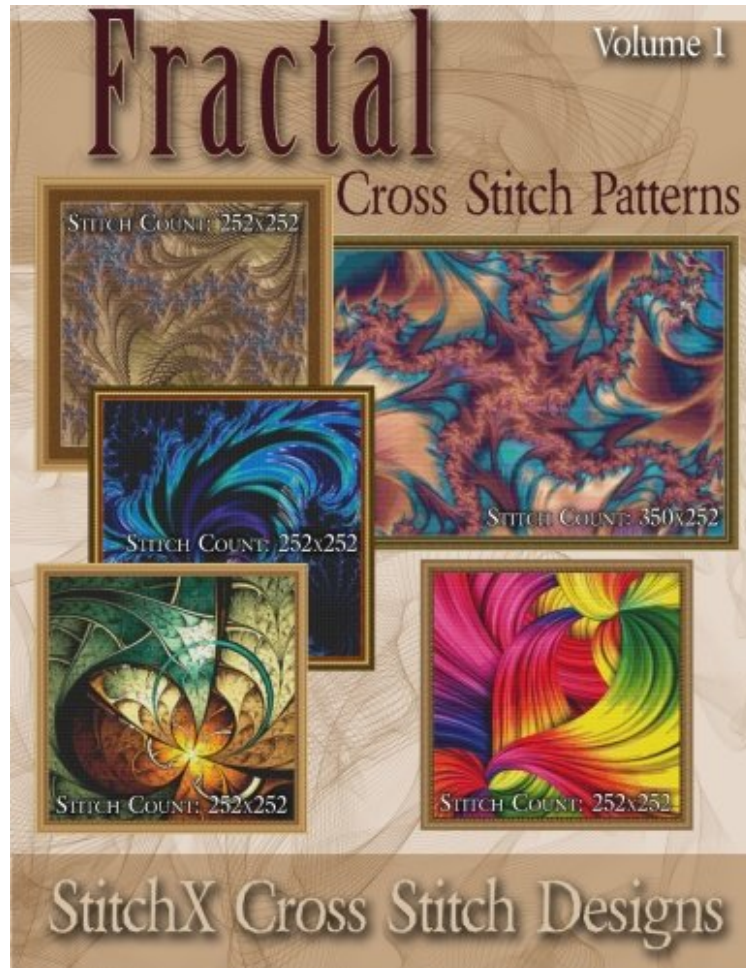

However I have done fractal patterns before and I "looked inside" this pattern book so I logged on to comment on the "easy to read" part. A fractal pattern by its very nature is not easy to read. Look at the colors and the complicated design in the pictures and you will know this isnt an easy pattern. There will not likely be large blocks of color to finish at one time. I did a fractal picture

on 16 count aida that was 350 stitches by 290 and it took me two years of dedicated stitching to finish. I am 48 and have been stitching since I was 10 and have stitched literally hundreds of projects and fractals are by far the most difficult thing I have ever done. And I had to teach myself a new way of reading the chart and change some of my stitching habits. My fractal pattern said it was good for beginners and if I was a beginner or even a moderate stitcher I would have given up the hobby as way too complicated. That being said, if you like to stitch or if you enjoy completing something complicated, I would encourage you to pick your favorite picture and give it a try. They are truly a beautiful work of art when they are finished. Mine is over 100 different colors in a shape that reminds me of nebula pictures from space. There is an unstitched "black hole" in the middle and when you stand back from the finished piece you can actually see the colors swirling together and getting lost in the black hole. It is well worth the time and effort to make one in my opinion but it is not an easy to read pattern or an easy to follow project in any way and I felt that someone should at least comment on that. I had eye strain every evening when I was done stitching and used many many line magnets and a very large magnet board to keep track of my place in the pattern.
